What to consider collecting

Government documents

Examples:

Annual reports

Reports to the United Nations (UN) or U.S.

Reports from a specific dept. (e.g., Dept. of Education)

Census material

Legal publications—legislature, congress

Journals

Compilations of laws and resolutions

Codes

Planning documents: economic development, education, health, etc.

Newsletters

Court reports

Special studies—fisheries, tourism, environment, etc.

Telephone directories

Churches—bibles, hymnals, devotional literature, studies of social problems

Local publishers

Magazines and newspapers

Music—tapes, CDs

“Film”—videos, DVDs

Banks—reports, newsletters

Nongovernmental organizations (NGOs) (e.g., Red Cross)
