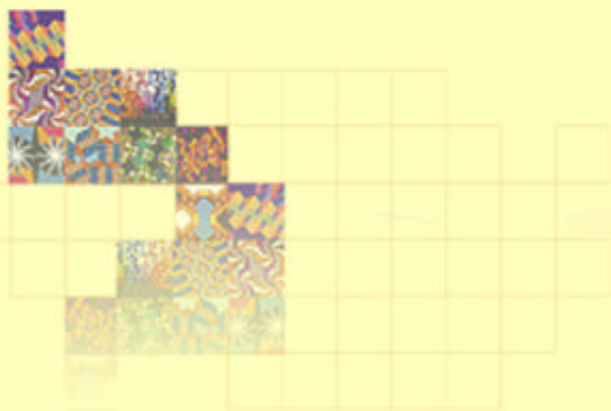


A Process Approach to Middle and Secondary School Mathematics: Algebra I

To launch the program

Macintosh users

- Insert the CD-ROM into the drive
- Double click the "Algebra 1" icon.

Windows users

- Insert the CD-ROM into the drive
- Double click on "My computer"
- Double click on "Algebra 1" (CD-ROM drive icon on your computer)
- Double click the "Algebra 1.exe" icon.

On the title page, double click on "start" to access the menu. This CD-ROM is easily navigated by selecting items under the key strands listed on the menu.

- Macintosh systems need QuickTime 4.0 or above and Acrobat Reader 4.0 or above
- Windows systems need QuickTime 4.0 or above and Acrobat Reader 4.0.5 or above.
